

Modifying Answer Values (Windows)

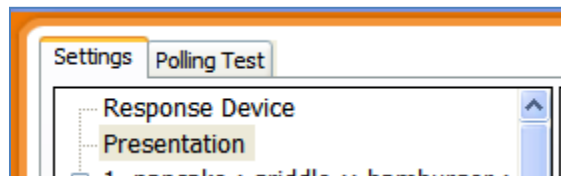
TurningPoint sets a default point value for all correct and incorrect answers (default “Presentation” value). However, you can modify this value for all your questions or you can set unique values for individual questions.

If you want a different numerical score other than the default, make sure you modify them **BEFORE** running the session because the resulting session file will record whatever value existed at the time.

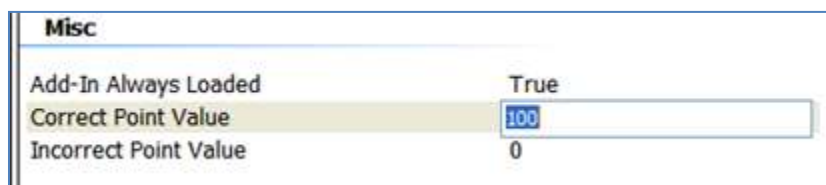
Set Default “Presentation” Values for All Questions in Current Presentation

The following steps explain how to set new default answer values for **all** new (or existing) questions in the current presentation file.

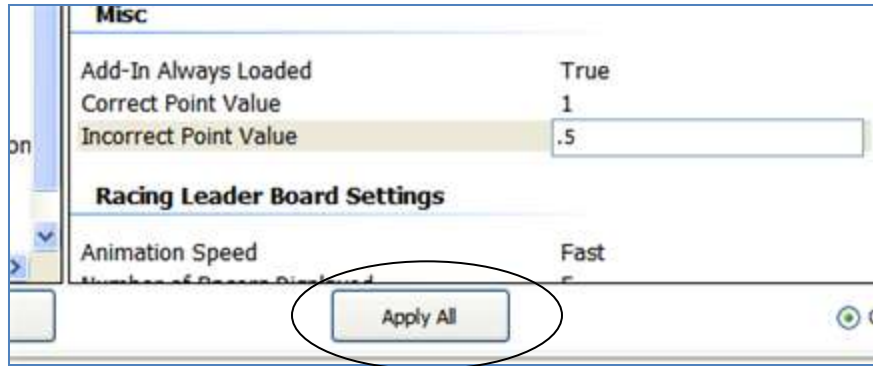
1. Open your TurningPoint presentation file.
2. In the TurningPoint toolbar, click **Tools > Settings**.
3. Select **Presentation**, on in the left side of the Settings window.



4. On the right, scroll down to the **Misc** heading.
5. If you want to change the default **Correct Point Value** setting, click on the displayed value and then type the new value. While the value is selected, click the **Apply All** button, *if* you want to apply this setting to all existing questions, as well.



6. While the value is selected, click the **Apply All** button, *if* you want to apply this setting to all existing questions, as well.

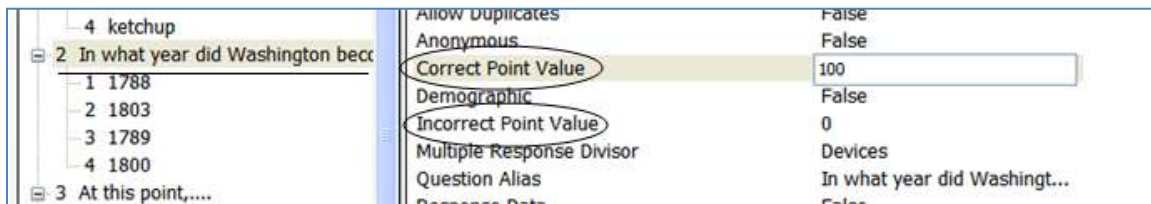


7. Repeat step 5. and 6. if you would like to modify the **Incorrect Point Value** settings for all questions.
8. Click the **Done** button, in the lower right of the window.

Set individual Question Answer Values in Current Presentation

If you need to set a different answer value for specific questions do the following:

1. Select a question on the left, and then enter the value, as shown below.



2. Once you've made your changes, just click the **Done** button in the lower right.
